The Scholarship Sponsors:

The Scholarship:

 - o The scholarship will be in the amount of \$1,500 (\$750 Fall 2024/\$750 Spring 2025).
- The recipient may also attend SWMO PRSA monthly membership meetings and one extended program free-of-charge during the academic year.

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be an undergraduate student beginning their junior or senior year or a graduate student pursuing a degree in communication, public relations or a closely related area.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time (taking a least 12 credit hours per semester undergraduate, 9 hours graduate) at one of the following institutions: College of the Ozarks, Drury University, Evangel University, Missouri State University, Missouri Southern State University, Ozarks Technical Community College or Southwest Baptist University.
- Selection of the scholarship winner will be based on interest and involvement in communications, academic standing and campus and/or community involvement.

- 1. A completed application form, including a 500-600 word essay (typed in the text boxes provided on the form) describing how the Dr. Joe McAdoo Memorial Scholarship will assist the student in achieving academic and career goals.
- 2. An updated resume (please emphasize items that highlight communication activities).
- 3. Official college transcripts.
